

Board Nomination Committee Charter

Purpose

The principal objectives of the Board Nomination Committee are as follows:

- developing and reviewing policies on Board composition, strategic function and size;
- · performance review process of the Board, its Committees and individual directors;
- · developing and implementing induction programs for new directors and ongoing education for existing directors;
- developing eligibility criteria for nominating directors;
- · recommending appointment of directors to the Board;
- · reviewing director independence; and
- · succession planning for the Board.

Structure

- · The committee shall comprise of a majority of independent non-executive directors of the Board.
- · The Chairman must be a non-executive director.

Remuneration

· Members of the Committee will not receive any additional remuneration beyond their directors' fees.

Meetings

- · A quorum for the meeting shall be two directors.
- · The committee should meet when considering appointment of a director and/or on an ad hoc basis.
